There are many famous places in the U.K. and Elizabeth Tower is one of the most popular places of these. When I went to the U.K. on a school trip, it left the best impression on me. I learned about the tower's appearance, function, and history, including the origin of its name through this school trip.

The first thing I noticed was that the tower is tall. It is 96.3 meters high. Second, it is a clock tower. It is a tower at the Palace of Westminster (Houses of Parliament) on the banks of London's River Thames, in the center of the city. There is a clock in the tower 55 meters above the ground. Gold plating was applied around the dial of the clock, and an iron frame was embedded with milky glass. I learned that the Elizabeth Tower clock is the largest chiming four-sided clock in the U.K.

Elizabeth Tower has a very big bell, which is known as Big Ben. It is two meters tall, and weighs 31.5 tons. Big Ben rings every 15 minutes and the sound can be heard up to eight kilometers away. I think that Elizabeth Tower fulfills its role as a clock tower well.

Elizabeth Tower has been an important tower for British people since it was completed in 1859. It took about 13 years to build. I think that it is the most famous clock tower in the world because it is very accurate. It was built in a Gothic style. Also, the tower survived a crisis. During World War II, even though the Houses of Parlia-
