Cut thick paper into lock by 20cm pieces. Next, fold it in half. Draw an outline of two Sumo wrestlers on the paper. Third, cut the paper with scissors along the outline. Finally, make the ring out of paper. Cut a piece of cardboard in a circle about 20 cm wide. It is easy to make. You don't need many things, just paper, a ring and a pen.

Next, I will tell you about how to play kamizumo and the rules. Two people can play this game. This game can be played in a house or anywhere. Before you start, make an empty box the sumo hing. Another person says "hakke yoi no kkota" in Japanese. The meaning this word is, "Are you ready?". You can't touch the sumo wrestler. Second, tap the corner of the box with your forefinger from the top. If a sumo wrestler goes outside the sumo ring or falls down, you lose. You win if you stay in the sumo ring without falling down. These rules are easy. Now you know how to play kamizumo.
