### How to Make and Play Bunbungoma

Do you know what Bunbungoma is? It is a toy which was in fashion during the Edo Era. The Edo Era was from 1603 to 1867. It is about 260 years and very long. The sound when Bunbungoma turns sounds like the wind blowing through the pine trees. You can make it easily with some common supplies which you can find around the house. Today, we will show you how to make and how to play Bunbungoma.

I would like to tell you how to make a Bunbungoma. Making a Bunbungoma is very easy. It takes me about five minutes. There are six materials and tools that you need: a piece of A4 cardboard, kite string, a pair of scissors, glue, a drill, and pens. First, draw two (5 cm) squares on the cardboard. Then, cut them out with the scissors. Next, stick the two squares together with glue. Draw two diagonal lines on the cardboard at 2mm from the center and find the center. Drill two holes in the center. If the holes are too big, you can't play it, so please be careful when you drill the holes. After that, cut the kite string about 1m. Finally, pass the kite string through the holes and tie the ends of

the kite string. This is the end. As you can see, making a

Bunbungoma is very easy. Please try making a Bunbungoma!

Next, I would like to tell you how to play the Bunbungoma.

First, please hang the string on the your index fingers, and a cardboard move at the center of the string.

The next, please twirl the Bunbungoma about (ten)

times. Please pull in right and left. And then

pull the string apart. So that the top begins to spin. Then

your Bunbungoma make a "bun bun" sound. If you want

to continue spin the Bunbungoma. Then you repeat the

same thing. The Bunbungoma has a lot of technics, but it

is easy once you get the hang of it.
